## HARRY BERTOIA untitled (Spill Cast)

USA, c. 1965 | bronze with patina 25% h  $\times$  26 w  $\times$  11 d in (65  $\times$  66  $\times$  28 cm)

Bertoia developed a technique of form-making called "Spill Cast" in which molten metal was poured into a pool or onto sand and pummeled with stones. The metal would cool into jagged and asymmetrical forms, producing a surface similar to coral. This unique example is exceptional for its three-dimensional qualities, setting it apart from other Spill Cast forms that are more planar in composition.
