CHARLES AND RAY EAMES early CTR

Herman Miller/Evans Products | USA, c. 1947 | plywood, chrome-plated steel, rubber
15¼ h × 35 w × 35 d in (39 × 89 × 89 cm)

A very rare example of the Eames CTR with three steel rod legs. Unlike production examples, this example has a circular connective support ring and rubber shock mounts, both adding an interesting visual feature to the design. A final three-leg version was available for less than two years, before the final version was produced with four legs. Evans paper label.
