Lot includes three models: *Cactus* coat rack designed by Guido Drocco and Franco Mello, *Torneraj* chair designed by Giorgio Ceretti, Riccardo Rosso and Piero Derossi (Gruppo Strum) and *Detecma* chair designed by the Italian physicist Tullio Regge. One of the first chairs designed on a computer, the Detecma is shaped after Dupin's Cyclide, an algebraic equation.
