Ateliers Jean Prouvé | France, 1945/c. 1970 | enameled steel, terrazzo
29¼ h × 81 w × 29¾ d in (76 × 206 × 76 cm)

This form was originally designed for the Flavigny Sanatorium in 1945 and put into wider production in the 1950s. The table tops of the original models were fragile and in the 1970s the design was modified to accommodate a thicker, more sturdy composite stone table top.
