

This lot includes four miniature replicas of structures that were never completed: Étienne-Louis Boullée's *Newton's Cenotaph* (1784), Vladimir Tatlin's *Monument to the Third International* (1919), Adolf Loos' *Chicago Tribune Column* (1922) and Antonio Sant'Elia's *Power Station* (1913).
