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FRIDA HANSEN tapestry

Det Norske Billedveveri | Norway, 1900 | hand-woven and plant-dyed wool

This tapestry features Frida Hansen's 'transparent' weaving technique and highlights her masterful use of negative and positive space. Considered one of the leading Art Nouveau artists in Norway of her time, this example features an abstracted forest motif rather than figurative imagery for which she is more well-known.
