Early vase, model 3031

littala | Finland, 1936 | mold-blown glass 11% h × 12½ w × 11 d in (30 × 31 × 28 cm)

Vase, model 3031 was originally part of a housewares collection submitted by Alvar Aalto to the Karhulalittala design competition of 1936. It would later come to be known as the $S\alpha voy$ vase after it was used in the Savoy Restaurant in 1937.

This particularly early example exhibits an amber hue and ridges along the base indicating that it was formed using a wood mold that slowly smoldered around the hot glass. A difficult material, the wood molds were later replaced with steel allowing the glass to stay in a molten state longer to reach a standardized shape.
