The present armchair is one of only four known examples of this model. The entire set and a similar settee was purchased from Metz & Co. in 1946 by Dr. Arend Isaäc Diepenhorst of Utrecht. In the 1980s, two armchairs and the settee were acquired by the Stedelijk Museum in Amsterdam and the Centraal Museum in Utrecht.
