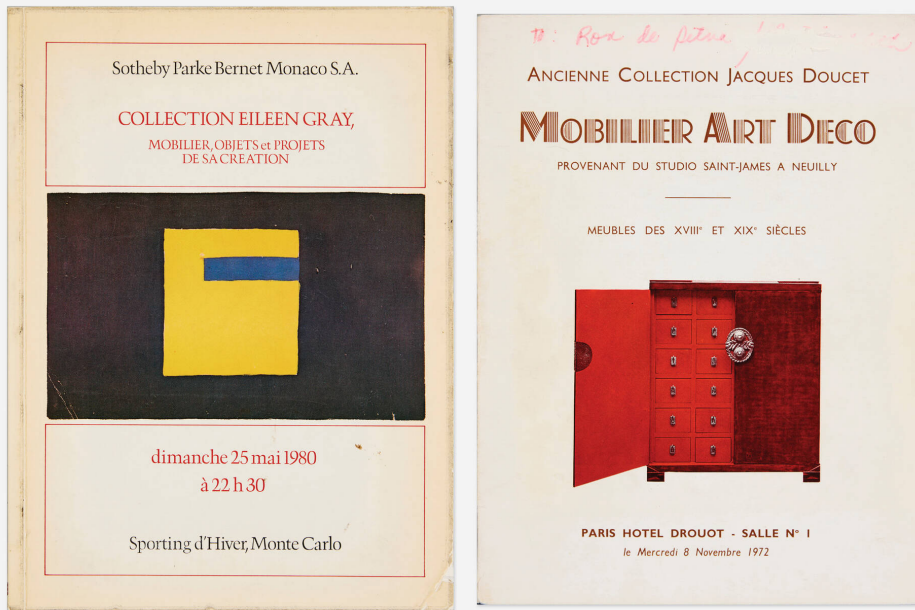

Ancienne Collection Jacques Doucet. Mobilier Art Deco provenant du Studio Saint-James a Neuilly, Audap, Godeau, Solanet, Paris, 11/08/1972. *Extremely rare. A legendary auction, drawing from the collection of the French fashion designer, with masterworks by Eileen Gray, Pierre Legrain, Marcel Coard, Rose Adler and others, several of which were acquired by Yves Saint Laurent. Indeed, the first significant price to be paid at auction for Art Deco, a figure high enough to be called “a world record for 20th Century furniture” was recorded when the Parisian-based American dealer Robert Walker paid \$36,000 on behalf of a private collector for Gray’s 1914 four-panel lacquered screen Le Destin.—JZ Faded pen inscription on the cover, minor loss to the paper in the same region, minor separation to the saddle stitched wrapper.*
