

The second of two iconic "Ford and Ford" titles. Perhaps my most treasured volume in this sale, I purchased it in January 2001, in preparation for my first auction at Phillips. The photographs of the furniture (many by Ezra Stoller and Julius Shulman) have served as the primary source of identification for generations of collectors. Breuer's furniture in the Frank House, Gilbert Rohde's plexiglass chair, the Organic Design Competition at MoMA and so much more.—JZ Dust jacket with losses, tears, even a cigarette burn on the back cover; otherwise, fine.

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
